This document remains the property of Her Majesty's Government.

Unlawful possession is Treason against Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and of the Dominion of British West Florida, and of her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

You must present this document when asked by competent local authorities.

You must surrender this document to ministers of the Crown of West Florida when asked.

If you are detained by local authorities, ask to speak to the Consul General.

Remember that you are a guest of the Government where you are traveling and that laws and customs differ. You may not have the same rights in foreign lands, and the Government of the Dominion of British West Florida's ability to render aid and comfort to you may be limited.

Do NOT demand your rights as a Citizen of the Dominion of British West Florida while in another Sovereign Nation.

You are advised to contact the local High Commission or Embassy of the Dominion of British West Florida upon arrival in foreign lands. Inform the Commission or Embassy of your in-country address and methods to contact you.

Should diplomatic conditions change, or natural events warrant evacuation, your Government may need to contact you very quickly.

If you find yourself in need of consular assistance, and are unable to contact a representative of the Dominion of British West Florida, contact the Consulate or High Commission of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland or another of Her Majesty's Realms.

Always be sure that someone in the Dominion of British West Florida knows your itinerary, make frequent contact with them.

Remember not all products which are legal in your host country may be imported into the Dominion. Check with customs before attempting to return with items made with skins, ivory, or shells.

Confirm with your physician the safety, legality, and effectiveness of all medications prescribed for you during your stay outside the Dominion. Some medication can not be imported into the Dominion.

Check with customs of the host country when bringing medications with you on your trip. Some governments restrict importation of medications that the Dominion of British West Florida considers to be both safe and effective.

The Government of the Dominion of British West Florida will not assist persons guilty of improper importation (or attempted export) of drugs, restricted animal products, or antiquities.
