# **This document remains the property of Her Majesty's Government.**

*Unlawful possession is Treason against Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and of the Dominion of British West Florida, and of her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.*

You must present this document when asked by competent local authorities.

You must surrender this document to ministers of the Crown of West Florida when asked.

If you are detained by local authorities, ask to speak to the Consul General.

Remember that you are a guest of the Government where you are traveling and that laws and customs differ. You may not have the same rights in foreign lands, and the Government of the Dominion of British West Florida's ability to render aid and comfort to you may be limited.

**Do NOT demand your rights as a Citizen of the Dominion of British West Florida while in another Sovereign Nation.**
