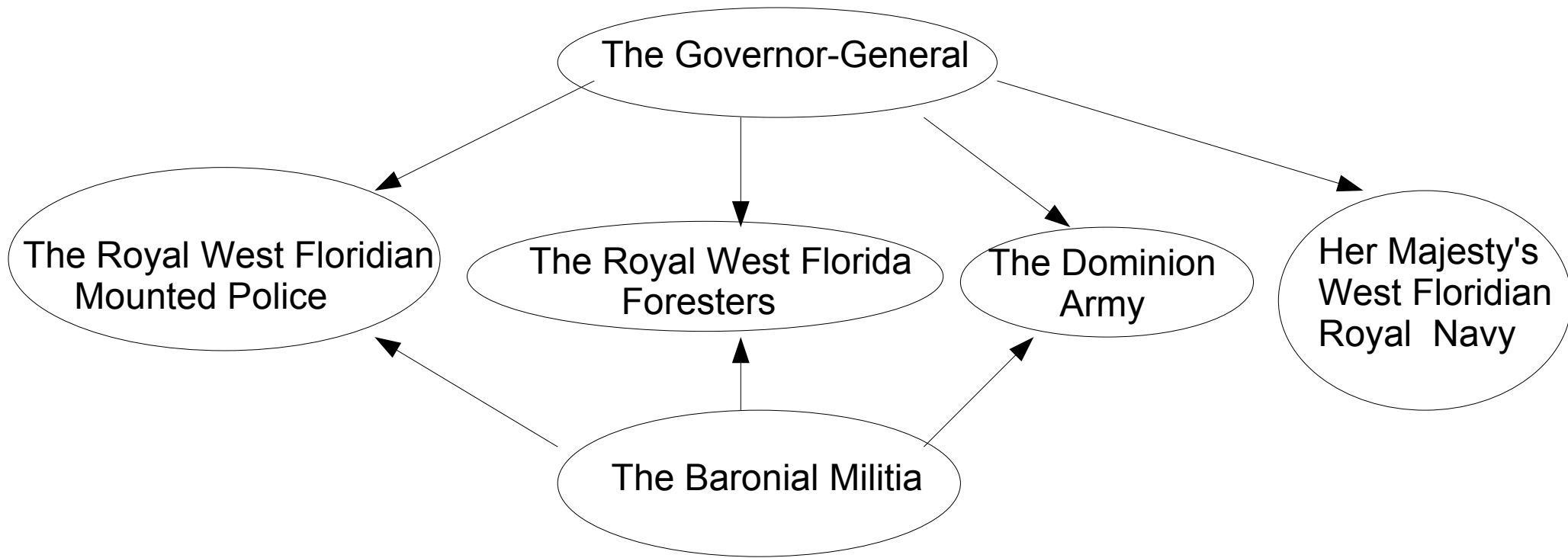


The Parliament of the Dominion of British West Florida consists of three equally important branches, the House of Commons – with its elected membership, the House of Lords – with its hereditary and appointed members, and the Queen or her Governor-General.

It isn't Parliament without all three present, and all laws flow from the Parliament. This is why the 'enacting clause' of all legislation includes the line '*By the Grace of the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons in Parliament Assembled, and by the Authority of the same, be it enacted....*'



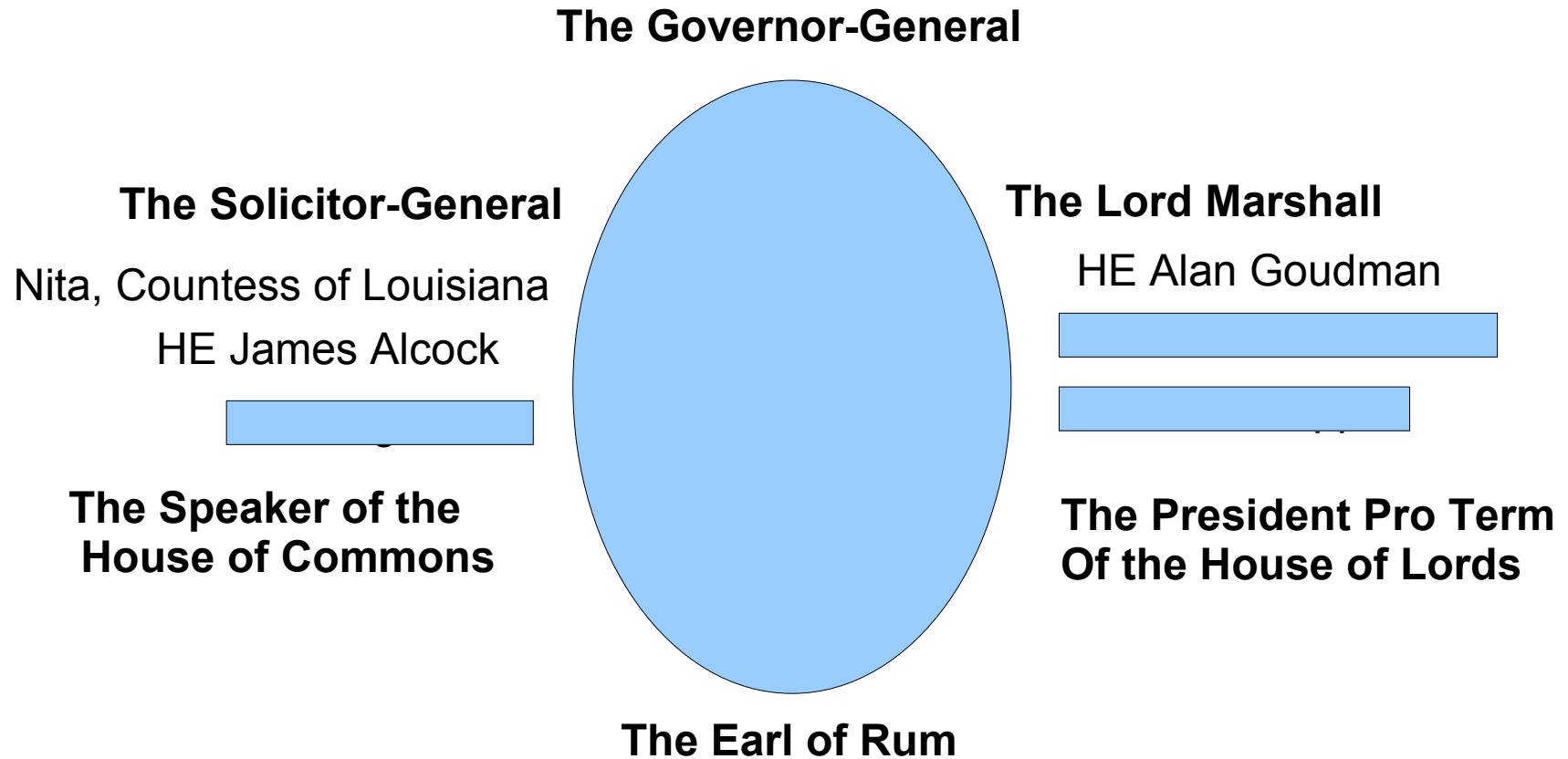
The Governor-General, as Her Majesty's Representative in this Dominion exercises all Executive Authority. This includes Command of the Armed Forces of the Dominion.

The RWFMP, and the RWFF are armed Officers of the Peace, serving by protecting the Queen's Highways and Forested Lands respectively.

The Dominion Army and the Royal Navy are the Military of the Dominion and train as such.

The Baronial Militias come under the authority of the Governor-General when they are activated into one of the 'domestic armed forces' of the Dominion.

Her Majesty's West Floridian Royal Navy is an all volunteer force,



The Privy Council is the Governor-General's executive Cabinet, or closest advisers. Some of the members of the Privy Council are traditionally members of the Council by virtue of their office (those listed in **Bold**), while others are personally chosen by the seating Governor-General.

(Note only those members of the Council whose names have been publicly named are listed – the full membership of the Council, its meetings and its records are State Secrets.)

Commandant and Colonel in Chief of the Regiments are appointed offices.

The Captain of Police is a Civil Service Job and requires previous experience as a Trooper. Patrolman can be a career option, but all Troopers require experience as a Patrolman.

Dispatcher and Clerk are civil service positions within the RWFMP that are not Armed Officers.

The Royal Forester for the Dominion, and the Forester in Chief for each of the Forests are Appointed Offices.

Forester is a civil service job and requires successfully meeting the basic requirements for Forest Ranger, Forestry Engineer, and Forest Fire-Marshall.

Rangers enforce the Law, Engineers manage forest production, and the Fire-Marshall protects against wild fires. Each of these positions have 'trainees or apprentices' below them.
